The top eight pony/rider combinations disregarding those already qualified. To be eligible for qualification, combinations must not exceed a total of four faults in the First Round. Please note qualification for HOYS only is pony/rider combination.

(a) Once the five pony/rider combinations have competed at the Pony European Championships they have automatically qualified for Horse of the Year Show and the British Showjumping National Championships. Should a pony/rider combination subsequently qualify then the qualification would go down the line.

(b) Up to four pony/rider combinations will qualify from the British Showjumping National Championships to the Horse of the Year Show, disregarding those already qualified in accordance with Rule 427.

Rules:

- Open to any pony not exceeding 128cms to be ridden by registered Members of The Pony Club up to the end of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 12. First Round max height 90cm. The Pony Club will provide a sash for the winner and 3 x rosettes for each qualifying competition.

- Members may enter as many of the qualifying rounds as they wish. All entries are to be made with the relevant show organiser in the usual way. Apart from the Northern Ireland competition, any Pony Club Member who wishes to take part in a qualifying round but is not a Member of British Show Jumping, or has a pony that is not registered with BS, can do so by purchasing a BS day ticket from the show at the time of entry. Those "riding on a ticket" are not eligible to receive prize money but will receive the Pony Club Rosette and sash and qualify to be chosen for Olympia if they win the class.

- The winner of each competition will qualify for the final at Olympia (subject to eligibility, see below) and following the completion of the final qualifying competition on 1st August a further 2 Members will be invited to compete at Olympia. This selection procedure, carried out by The Pony Club Chairman of Show Jumping, will be based on the results in the qualifiers and the home address of Members who featured in the line ups and is designed to ensure that at least one Member from Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland and England is chosen to take part at Olympia. The selection decisions of the Chairman of Show Jumping are final and no correspondence will be entered into after the 8 successful Members have been announced. In all cases where the qualified Member is unable to compete at Olympia, qualification will pass down the line to the next eligible Member.

Eligibility:

- Any rider who has taken part in The Pony Club Mini-Major at Olympia in previous years is not eligible.

- In order to be selected for the Mini Major, the rider must have paid their Pony Club Membership fee in full by 28th February in the current year and must have attended at least 3 Branch/Centre or Area rallies between 1st July 2018 and the date of the qualifying competition. (Team training does not count as a rally, see the Pony Club Handbook for further information).

- An application form will be sent by The Pony Club to each rider provisionally selected for Olympia. Before selection can be confirmed, this form must be completed and returned by a parent or guardian and signed by the DC of the Member's branch. Amongst the information requested on the form will be full details and dates of the rallies attended by the Member.

There are specific dress and conduct rules which the Olympia London International Horse Show set for the Mini-Major and these must be complied with. Details will be sent to the selected Members.
