Entry fees:

Classes 1a, 2a, 3a, 4a: £26.00 (includes first aid)

Classes 1b, 2b, 3b, 4b: £28.00 (included first aid)

Entries close: 24th January

Entries will be taken on a first come basis and a waitlist will be held. Full refunds, less an admin fee of £5.00 will be refunded up to the closing date. After this date, there will be no refunds.

All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis.

Rules:

Please make yourselves aware of the Arena Eventing Rules available at www.pcuk.org

- Open to Pony Club Members and Non-Members
- A copy of the Pony Club Spring Festival Arena Eventing rules will be displayed on the day
- Riders cannot compete in more than two classes per day. Horses/ponies cannot compete more than once in each class or in more than two classes
- Competitors may qualify a max of two horses and /or ponies for any Championship class. Riders/Horses/ponies and/or combination of horse and rider can qualify for more than one Championship class.
- All Entries to be submitted online via www.horse-events.co.uk
- Entries will be taken on a first come basis and a waitlist will be held. Full refunds, less an admin fee of £5.00 will be refunded up to the closing date. After this date, there will be no refunds.
- In the event of cancellation notification will be posted on the East Devon Hunt PC Website and facebook page. In the event of a cancellation, monies will be refunded less £5 per entry administration fee.

- This competition will include a variety of show jumps and cross country style jumps. It will be run as a SINGLE ROUND competition with two phases, the first phase with show jumps, and the second phase with the cross country style jumps. All competitors proceed to the second phase whether faults have been incurred or not, apart from eliminated riders. The second phase has a timed section. Stop watches are NOT permitted
- All competitors will jump both phases (unless they have been eliminated) the winner being the closest to the optimum time in the second phase with the lowest number of faults. Rider fall will result in elimination. The competition will be run under Pony Club Rules 2020/21
- Scoring will be on Pony club results at <https://www.ponyclubresults.co.uk/>
- The Judges decision is final.
- All hats MUST NOT be fixed peak and must comply with current Pony Club Rule book. Failure to comply may result in elimination. Hats must be tagged with the aquamarine tag.
- Body protectors BETA 2009 [LEVEL3] purple label compulsory
- The Pony Club Saddlery and Dress rules will be strictly enforced see www.pcuk.org/index.php/dcs_health_safety/dress_and_tack/
- The warm up Arena will be stewarded – no other person is allowed in. The jumps in the warm-up arena will not exceed the height of the jumps in the ring.
- All dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times
- All droppings to be picked up and taken home
- No horses/ponies are to be left unattended when tied to the lorry/trailer
