The time allowed is two minutes in an outdoor arena, 90 seconds indoors. Points are scored in accordance with Rule 277 (Fault and Out). The order of starting must be drawn.

This competition is for teams of two competitors. Both members of the team enter the arena together. The first competitor crosses the starting line and jumps the course until he/she makes an error, continuing to jump the course a second time if still clear as in Rule 277.8.3.

As soon as the competitor makes an error the bell is rung. The other team member (the rescuer) must take over and continue the course at the next obstacle beyond the point at which the error occurred. Failure to do so incurs elimination. Each team member continues to rescue the other whenever an error is made.

At the end of the time allowed the bell is rung and the competitor who is then jumping must cross the finishing line. Failure to do so incurs the elimination of the team.

The competition is decided on points. In the event of equality of points time between the first competitor crossing the starting line and the last competitor crossing the finishing line after the time allowed has been reached decides.
